### **Fifth Peaceful Community Protest Planned Over Proposed Recovery Campus in San Pedro**

**San Pedro, CA** – The South Shores Community Association (SSCA) and San Pedro Neighborhood Alliance will hold its FIFTH peaceful protest opposing the proposed placement of a Fred Brown Recovery Services facility at a location that currently houses senior residents.

#### **WHO:**

SSCA along with Harbor Area residents and community members, will hold its FIFTH peaceful protest opposing the proposed Serenity Recovery Campus at the former Little Sisters of the Poor property in San Pedro.

#### **WHAT:**

Community members are protesting the State of California's preliminary approval of more than \$73 million in funding tied to the proposed Serenity Recovery Campus operated by Fred Brown Recovery Services.

According to publicly reported plans, the proposal includes:

- A 122-bed residential recovery facility
- Services for justice-involved individuals and those struggling with substance abuse and mental health challenges
- Hundreds of outpatient visits daily

Residents have raised concerns about the potential displacement of approximately 70 current senior residents living at Ocean View Village, as well as the impact on the surrounding residential community.
